'Siren Arts: Salt' brings performance art back to Asbury Park

This summer, art is all around us in Asbury Park.

Siren Arts: Salt," the sixth annual summer arts residency from nonprofit visual arts organization Transformer runs July 11 through Aug. 18 in the city.
