E19: Artistic Interventions debuts four solo two-week exhibitions by *E19* artists, Chris Combs, Adele Kenworthy, Vonne Napper, and Jordana Rubenstein-Edberg.

Throughout this rigorous peer mentorship program, the *E19* artists explored artistic interventions in their myriad forms and interpretations, with guidance and support from *E19* lead mentor Dawne Langford as well as from *E19* mentor artists Monica Jahan Bose, Mel Chin, Philippa Hughes, Mark Strandquist, and Naoko Wowsugi.

The resulting summer activations at Transformer will explore and intervene on themes including: digital surveillance, the gender binary, forms of rest and care, and gentrification.
